PERFORMANCE-CUM-ACHIEVEMENT REPORT

The policy of All India Sports Council of the Deaf is to give maximum possible opportunities for competition at national and state levels to deaf sportspersons of all age groups. Having won 3rd place in Volleyball in the VI Asia Pacific Games of the Deaf held at Chinese Taipei in 2000 and India's 1st Participation in 1st World Deaf Volleyball Championship, Buenos Aires (Argentina) has proved that India is capable Team in World Arena. We have now the added responsibility to keep on winning medals for aiming gold. As a result of our continued efforts, the deaf in the country has become sports conscious and thus have also raised their standard of performance to new heights.

In the past, India already participated in Overseas Volleyball recently in 2008 i.e. 1st World Deaf Volleyball Championship, Buenos Aires, Argentina. In this, AISCD have already selected 32 probable players on the basis of performance displayed during 15th National Volleyball Championship of the Deaf held at Gurgaon and the coaching camp already been conducted in New Delhi in the month of June and July 2008 for over one month under the coaching of Sports Authority of India for vigorous camp to improve the player's form.

The 16th National Deaf Volleyball Championship was most successfully conducted by Delhi Sports Council of the Deaf at Bharati College, Janakpuri and Saraswati Bal Mandir, Hari Nagar from 25th to 29th March, 2010 despite short Notice following the cancellation by Haryana Sports Council of the Deaf and UP Sports Council of the Deaf due paucity of funds and non availability of funds due to coming Commonwealth Games 2010 to be held in New Delhi.

10 States comprising 13 teams in Men & Women Categories representing various states from all over India were participated in the championship.

The Championship was inaugurated by MCD Councilor on 26th March 2010 at 10.00 am in a colourful glittering function well attended by large players, officials, office bearers and EB members of AISCD and its state organizations, sports loving general public etc.

Immediately after the inauguration ceremony, the league matches for all the groups started. More than 30 matches were conducted on league round. As was expected the standard of play was very high throughout the championship. The large crowd of spectators was very actively supported every teams that have made some ever memorable moments in volleyball techniques. As in the past, Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh has maintained its supremacy in Mens Group and in female groups Gujarat has won the title.

Since there was on overall improvement in the standard of play in all categories, we can firmly state that the championship has served its purpose for which it was organized i.e., to provide opportunity for participation in a national level competition with high standards.

The MCD Councilor gave away the medals and certificates to the winners in a glittering closing ceremony held at Hari Nagar on 29th March, 2010 at the venue in the presence of guest of honour/chief guest.

Delhi Sports Council of the Deaf has made necessary arrangements for the competitions, stay and food of participants and officials. The technical management was done in association with Delhi Volleyball Association and SAI.
