As a policy matter of the All India Sports Council of the Deaf to organize Nationals in as many disciplines of Sports and Games, as is possible, the Madhya Pradesh Deaf Sports Society, Indore has agreed to host the XX National Chess Championship of the Deaf in collaboration with its district body the Mahakaushal Association of the Deaf as Co-Host, conducted at Agrasen Kalyaan Mandapa, Vijay Nagar, Ranital Sports Complex, Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh State on December, 27th – 31st, 2017.

Approximately 300 deaf Chess players representing 21 affiliated states consisting of Seniors, Juniors and Sub-Juniors (Boys and Girls combined) gathered at the Ranital Sports Complex. The co-host under leadership of Mr. Sanjay Soni, Organising Secretary, XX NCCD had made elaborate arrangement for lodging and boarding for the participants.
