3. Such of the team – member who might be Central Government Servants are to be treated as on duty (Which include deputation abroad) in respect of the participation by the Departure / Office in which they are employed in teams of Department Personnel & Training O.M. No. 6/1/85-Est. (Pay-1) dated 30.1.1989. The **AISCD** should inform their employing Department/ Office accordingly.
4. It is requested that Indian High Commission/ Embassy in **Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia** and organizers of the event may please be informed of the travel plans and itinerary of the delegation for participation in above event. The team members may be advised to call on the Mission for exchange of views.
5. A report on the visit of the team along with its **performance / achievement** in the above Event may please be sent to SP IV/TEAMS Division, SAI within 7 days of the return of the team to India along with **some action photographs**, if possible.

1. ****Respect and Sportsmanship****

- Treat all participants, officials, and spectators with respect, regardless of nationality, culture, or background.
- Display good sportsmanship at all times, acknowledging both victories and defeats gracefully.

2. ****Integrity and Honesty****

- Compete fairly and honestly, adhering to all rules and regulations of the sport.
- Avoid any form of cheating, including the use of performance-enhancing substances.

3. ****Teamwork and Collaboration****

- Foster a spirit of teamwork, supporting teammates and working collaboratively to achieve common goals.
- Communicate openly and respectfully with coaches, teammates, and staff.

4. ****Discipline and Commitment****

- Attend all training sessions, meetings, and scheduled events punctually.
- Follow the training and competition schedules provided by the coaching staff.

5. ****Discipline and Conduct****

- Maintain a professional demeanor at all times, both on and off the field.
- **Harassment Policy:** No player shall make vulgar comments or engage in any form of sexual harassment. All team members are expected to foster a safe and respectful environment.
- Males and females should adhere to appropriate decorum regarding accommodations. Room-sharing or interchanging rooms must only occur with prior permission from the coach.

6. ****Conduct Off the Field****

- Maintain a positive and professional demeanor at all times, both on and off the field.
- Refrain from engaging in any behavior that could harm the team's reputation or the spirit of the games.

7. **Cultural Sensitivity**

- Respect the customs, traditions, and values of the host country and fellow participants.
- Be open-minded and adaptable to different cultural practices.

8. **Health and Safety**

- Prioritize health and safety by following all medical and safety guidelines.
- Report any health issues or concerns to the team medical staff promptly.

9. **Social Media Responsibility**

- Be mindful of social media use, ensuring that all posts reflect positively on the team and adhere to the values of respect and integrity.
- Do not share confidential team information or engage in negative commentary about competitors or officials.

10. **Compliance with Authority**

- Follow all instructions and guidelines set forth by coaches, team leaders, and officials.
- Accept decisions made by officials and accept penalties or sanctions without protest.

11. **Consequences of Violations**

- Understand that violations of this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, which could include warnings, suspension, or removal from the team and further participation will be banned.

This Code of Conduct serves to uphold the integrity of our team and the spirit of International and National competition. All team members are expected to read, understand, and commit to these guidelines for a successful and respectful experience.

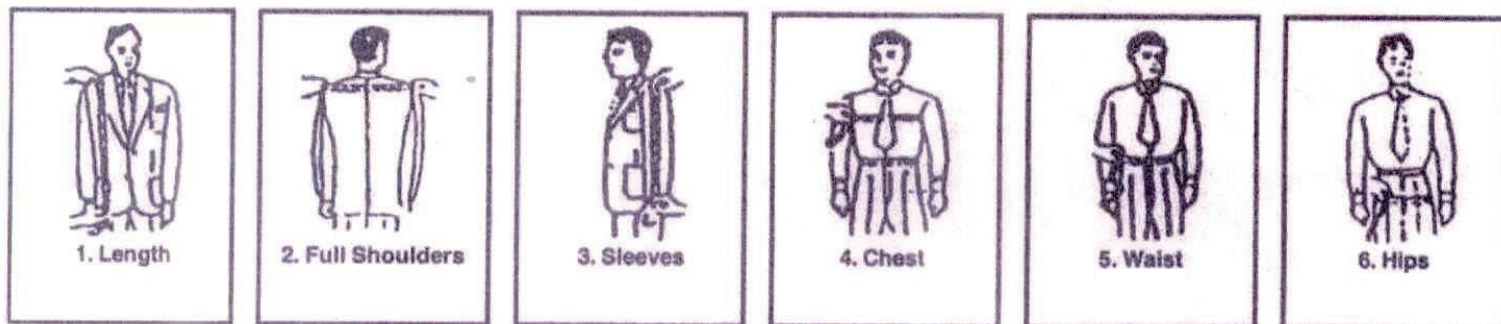

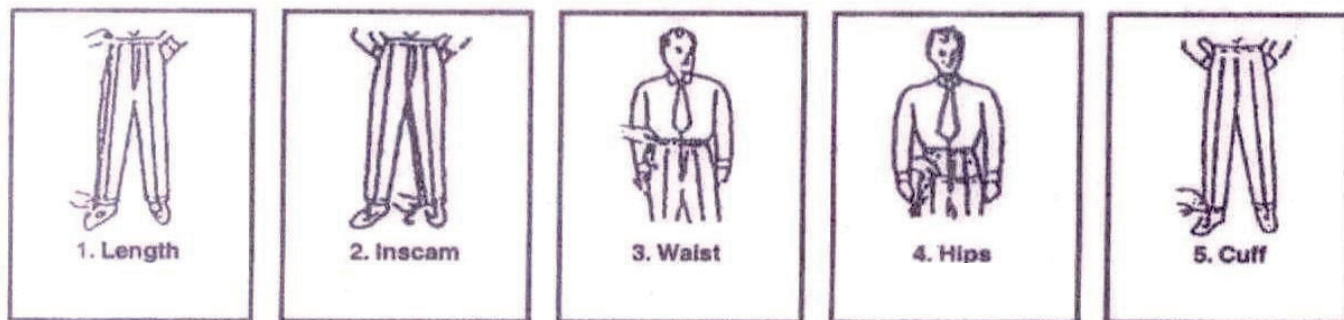
Measurement Chart – 10TH Asia Pacific Deaf Games 2024
