MEMORANDUM – 1

Sub: - National Coaching Camp and National Selection Trial of Athletics and Volleyball –

- 5th World Deaf Volleyball Championships, Tomigusuku, Japan on June 21-30, 2024
- 1st World Deaf Youth & 5th World Deaf Athletics Championships, Taipei, Chinese Taipei on July 12 to 21, 2024

This is to inform you all that due to the pending court case filed by Adv. Rahul Mehra, the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India, New Delhi withhold to release the financial assistance for any National Championship indefinitely. After long discussion with the Director and Deputy Director (Sports), Atal Bihari Vaipayjee Training Centre for Disability Sports, Gwalior at New Delhi on 27-02-2024, AISCD has decided to select the athletes in the discipline of (1) Athletics and (2) Volleyball based on their performance of the recent 25th National Deaf Senior & 8th National Deaf Junior & Sub Junior Sports Championships, Indore in February 2023 and National Selection Trial held at SAI Playground, Bangalore in October 2023. The list of the selected athletes is attached. AISCD has appointed the following Officials:

- Mr. N. V. Nishad Kumar, Trivandrum, Kerala - Athletics Head Coach
- Ms. Aleyamma Joseph, Thiruvalla, Kerala - Athletics Assistant Coach
- Mr. Balaji B. A., Bangalore, Karnataka - Volleyball Head Coach
- Mr. T. V. Manohar, Bangalore, Karnataka - Volleyball Assistant Coach (Deaf)

And AISCD has decided to conduct the 10-Day National Coaching Camp and thereafter 01-day Selection Trial at the Atal Bihari Vaipayjee Training Centre for Disability Centre, Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh under the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment during the month of April 2024 itself. The tentative date of the programme is given below:

Period of Camp	: 10 days – From 12 th April to 20 th / 21 st April 2024
Arrival date	: 11 th April 2024 Afternoon
Coaching Start Date	: 12 th April 2024 Morning
Trial Selection	: 21 st April 2024 – Athletics 22 nd April 2024 – Athletics (Remaining) and Volleyball
Departure date	: 23 rd April 2024 Morning

Food will be provided to all campers at cost to AISCD. Accommodation and Playground will be provided at free charge by the Centre for Disability Sports, Gwalior. No sort of any allowance like Travel Expenses, etc will be paid during the Camp and Trial.

Such of the team-members who might be State and Central Government Servants, are to be treated as Special Casual Leave / On Duty in respect of the Coaching Camp for the period of Journey and camp as per OMs No: 6/1/85- Estt.(Pay-1) dated 16-07-1985 and 6/2/85-Estt.(Pay-1) dated 30-01-1989 of Government of India and those category deaf sportspersons are asked to obtain leave from their departments by quoting the above Government Orders at the earliest.

Any athlete whose name is not included in the List of the selected athletes may take part in the Selection Trial on 21-04-2024 and 22-04-2024 without providing food and accommodation at the campus.

Strictly no parents or relative or personal coach will be allowed inside the Campus during the Camp and Trial, failing which strict disciplinary action is liable to be taken against the concerned athlete.

All the AISCD Affiliated State Units are requested to take action to publish the same through Media and ensure to send the athletes to Gwalior positively.
