2. Section 9 of FC(R) Act, 1976, Provides inter-alia that no member of a legislature, office bearer of a political party, judge, Government servant or employee of any corporation shall accept any foreign hospitality without the prior permission of central Government. In case, any team member is covered under the above act, he/she obtain the prior permission from Ministry of Home Affairs before their departure Vladimir, Russian Federation.

- 3. As regards foreign exchange required for above participation on the federation is requested to approach authorized dealers for getting foreign exchange in view of RBI circular No.41 A.D(M.A.series) dated 25.1.97.
- 4. Such of the team -member who might be central Government Servants are to treated as on duty (which include deputation abroad) in respect of the participation by the Department Personal & Training O.M.No. 6/1/85-Est. (pay-1) dated 30.1.1989. The federation should inform their employing Department / Office accordingly.
- 5. It is requested that Indian High Commission /Embassy in Vladimir, Russian Federation and organizers of the event may please be informed of travel plans and itinerary of the delegation for participation in above event.

The team members may be advised to call on Mission for exchange of view.

PA report on the visit team along with its performance /achievement in the above event may please sent to SAI within 7 days of the return of the team to India along with some action photographs, if possible.

I am directed to convey the financial sanction of Competent Authority, in principle, for the subject International Exposure, as per following break-up of financial assistance and Terms and Conditions:-

- 2. I am also directed to convey the sanction of Competent Authority to the payment of a sum of Rs.3,86,100/- i.e. 75% to the total estimated expenditure of Rs.5,14,800/- as an advance to All India Sports Council of the Deaf (AISCD) in respect of Registration fee, ISCD fee, Hospitality Boarding & lodging.
- 3. The amount sanctioned herein will be drawn by the Drawing & Disbursing Officer, Sports Authority of India on the prescribed bill immediately for disbursing the same to grantee through Electronic Clearing System. This grant is of non-recurring nature.
- 4. The grant is subject to the conditions mentioned below:-
 - That the grantee shall execute a bond for the full amount of grant in the prescribed proforma on a non-judicial stamp paper in acceptance of the terms and conditions

of the grant duly executed by the authorized signatory of the grantee and two sureties and witnesses with complete permanent addresses.

The grantee shall maintain subsidiary accounts of the grant received from the ii)

The grantee shall maintain the register of assets in the prescribed form GFR-19. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant except those declared as iii) obsolete and unserviceable or condemned as per the procedure laid down in the General Financial Rules shall not be disposed off without the prior approval of the

The grantee shall not divert the grants and entrust execution of the scheme or work concerned to another Institution or Organizations and shall abide by the terms & iv) conditions of the grant. If the grantee fails to utilize the grant, for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned, the grantee will required to refund the entire

amount of the grant with interest thereon @ 10% per annum. The Utilization Certificate in the prescribed form GFR - 19 A disclosing whether the specified, quantified and qualitative targets that should have been reached against V) the amount utilized, were in fact reached and if not the reasons therefore should be submitted within six months of the completion of the program along with the audited statement of accounts. The UC should be checked and signed by the Chartered Accountant with reference to the initial and subsidiary accounts of the

grant to be maintained by the grantee as per GFRs. The performance-cum-achievement report in respect of the above event for which the grant has been sanctioned should be forwarded to the TEAMS DIVISION, Sports vi) Authority of India with a copy to Government Observer within one week of the

That some photographs of the events, i.e. events, medal winners etc. with sample invitation cards for opening and closing ceremony and copies of newspaper clippings vii) related to the event preferably in National and Regional dailies be sent to this office along with performance-cum-achievement report.

That the amount in INR will be subject to the actual rate of Foreign Exchange on the date of payment by the Federation. The difference, if any, in INR will be adjusted.

There is no reason to believe that the grantee is involved in corrupt practice. ix)

That no advertisement of Tobacco and Liquor will be displayed during the event, the breach of which entails the cancellation of grant. X)

Amount of grant should be utilized only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and unspent balance of grant shall be refunded by the grantee institution xi) immediately after conclusion of the event.

The grantee should maintain separate accounts for the grants released by the Sports Authority of India. The accounts of the amount so paid to the grantee shall xii) be open to check by an officer deputed by Sports Authority of India or the Government in addition to other statutory authorities to ensure proper utilization of the funds and that no profits are earned out this.

The grantee shall also submit consolidated accounts of the grants received from other Ministries/Departments/State Governments for detailed checking by the xiii) Sports Authority of India, in addition to the separate annual accounts on the activities implemented with the grants released by the Sports Authority of India.

The grant is further subject to the conditions laid down in General Financial Rules xiv) as amended from time to time.

The fact the program is sponsored by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports/ Sports Authority of India should be prominently highlighted and displayed while xv) inviting people and holding functions/programs/events etc.

When the Sports Authority of India/Government of India/State Government has reasons to believe that the sanctioned money is not being utilized for the approved xvi) purposes, the payment of the grant will be stopped. If the reply to the show cause notice is not satisfactory, the earlier grant will be recovered with interest as

The grantee institution or organization should exercise reasonable economy in the xvii)

As per GFR-212(1), the accounts of grantee institution or organization shall be opened to inspection by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports/Sports Authority of xviii) India and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit of Sports Authority of India, New Delhi, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so.

The above sanction has been issued under the powers delegated to the Director General/Secretary/Executive Director of Sports Authority of India. It is certified that the grant being released is in conformity with the rules and regulations of the scheme as approved by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.

10. The amount of Rs. 3,86,100/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Eighty Six Thousand One Hundred only) shall be drawn and transferred to All India Sports Council of the Deaf (AISCD) for the above participation.

11. The amount of grant will be debitable to the Major Head 49.0500, Sub Head ------- (Assistance to National Sports Federations) for the Financial Year 2018-19.

INDIA BAGGED ONE GOLD AND THREE BRONZE MEDALS

Indian Deaf Wrestling Team has bagged One Gold and Three Bronze Medals in the 3rd World Deaf Cadel and Junior and 5th World Deaf Senior Greco-Roman and Freestyle Wrestling Championships 2018 conducted at Ice Palace Polaris, Vladimir, Russian Federation from June 11 to 19, 2018, the Medal Tally is as follows:

CADET CATEGORY (16-17 Years)

Date: 19-June-2018

Ritik (Haryana) – Bronze Medalin 51 kg Freestyle

JUNIOR CATEGORY (18 - 20 Years)

- 1. Amit Krishan (Haryana) Gold Medal in 70 kg Freestyle
- 2. Shubham Babaso Patil (Maharashtra) Bronze Medal in 92 kg Freestyle

SENIOR CATEGORY (18 Years and Above)

- 1. Ajay Kumar (Haryana) got Bronze Medal in 65 kg Freestyle
- 2. Amit Krishan (Haryana) got Diploma 4th place in 70 kg Freestyle

Amit Krishan aged 19 has entered in both Junior and Senior Categories wherein on 17th he lost and got 4th place by missing Bronze Medal in Senior Category and the next day 18th he got God Medal in Junior Category.

The team consisting of 7 wrestlers (1 Cadet, 3 Junior and 3 Senior) with Shri. Maha Singh Rao, (Dronacharya Awardee, SAI Chief Wrestling Coach) Chief Coach and Shri. Chand Pasha, (Ex-National Deaf Wrestler) Assistant Coach went on 15th June to Vladimir, Russian Federation and they are returning back to New Delhi Airport Terminal 3 on Wednesday 20th June by Aeroflot SU 234 about 23:50 hrs. The expenses incurred were at Full Cost to Government by SAI through All India Sports Council of the Deaf (AISCD) which is the only Sports Apex Body of Deaf in India. Initially it was planned to send 10 wrestlers, but three of them could not go due to Passport problems, and all of them were sure to get Medals. The teams will be received at Airport and they will be honoured at SAI Office on Thursday, 21st June, 2018 and plan to meet Col. Rajy avardhan Singh Rathore, Hon'ble Union Minister of State for Youth Affairs & Sports.
